The Mitsubishi Electric Hall (Siegburger Str. 15, 40591 Düsseldorf) may be reached from the A46 Highway by taking the Düsseldorf-Wersten exit. There are limited number of parking places. Therefore, we recommend carpooling, a pilgrim bus or public transportation.

There are reserved parking places directly next to the hall for all pilgrim buses. If you plan to take the S-Bahn, your stop is “Oberbilk”, very close to the hall.
